II	Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:
	<p>1. Construction of protection wall on both sides of Ferozpur nallah and demarcation of its catchment area 2. Repair, renovation and maintenance of road from Haudatboora to Gulebdagi 3. First Aid center at Gulebdagi or Haripora 4. Considering upper hilly or kandi villages (Kharpora, Harpora and Gulebdagi for sheep rearing) 5. Development of vegetable clusters</p>
