2. Sanitation problem. There are old latrine pits, damaged latrine, due to overgrowth of weeds
3. In well-being centre P.T. is required.
4. More room for program in women's centre.
5. Proper cleanliness of Canal from time to time so that water can be used for agricultural purpose.
6. For the other development (e.g. B.V.V. & K.V.S. etc.) required for urgent public demands that was not followed earlier but now not been accepted so far.

1. Personnel transfer is required at well-being centre.

2. Where representation are received and are attached herewith. One for Const A building at a point of Chandra-Pan tik. In the top of a house at Chandra-Pan tik at Junction station.

3. In Const A, a concrete bridge at Pankaj

The overall public is happy with functioning of B.V.V. and Pankaj. Water programme B.V.V. is quite fruitful. One major suggestion there should be sanitation drive & the water board problem drainage system for the well-being of the public at large.
