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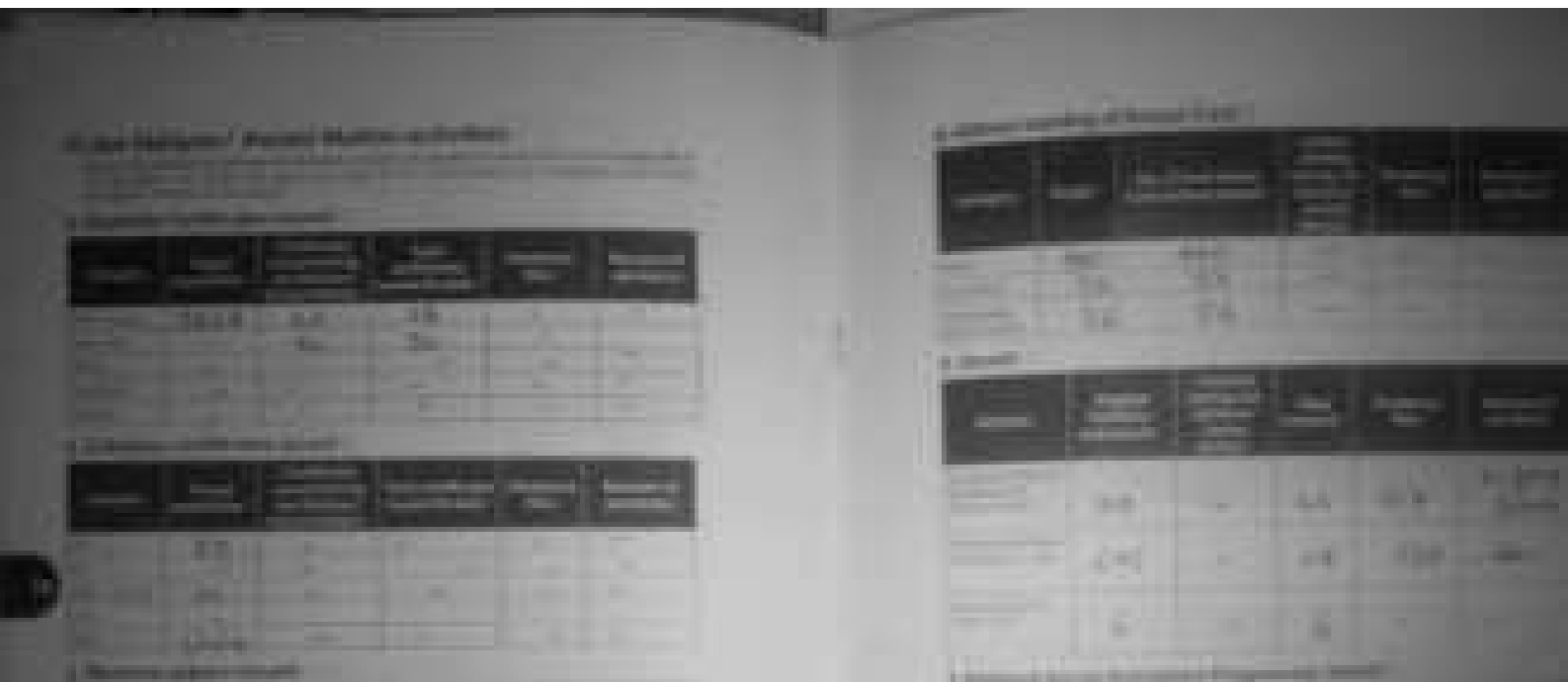

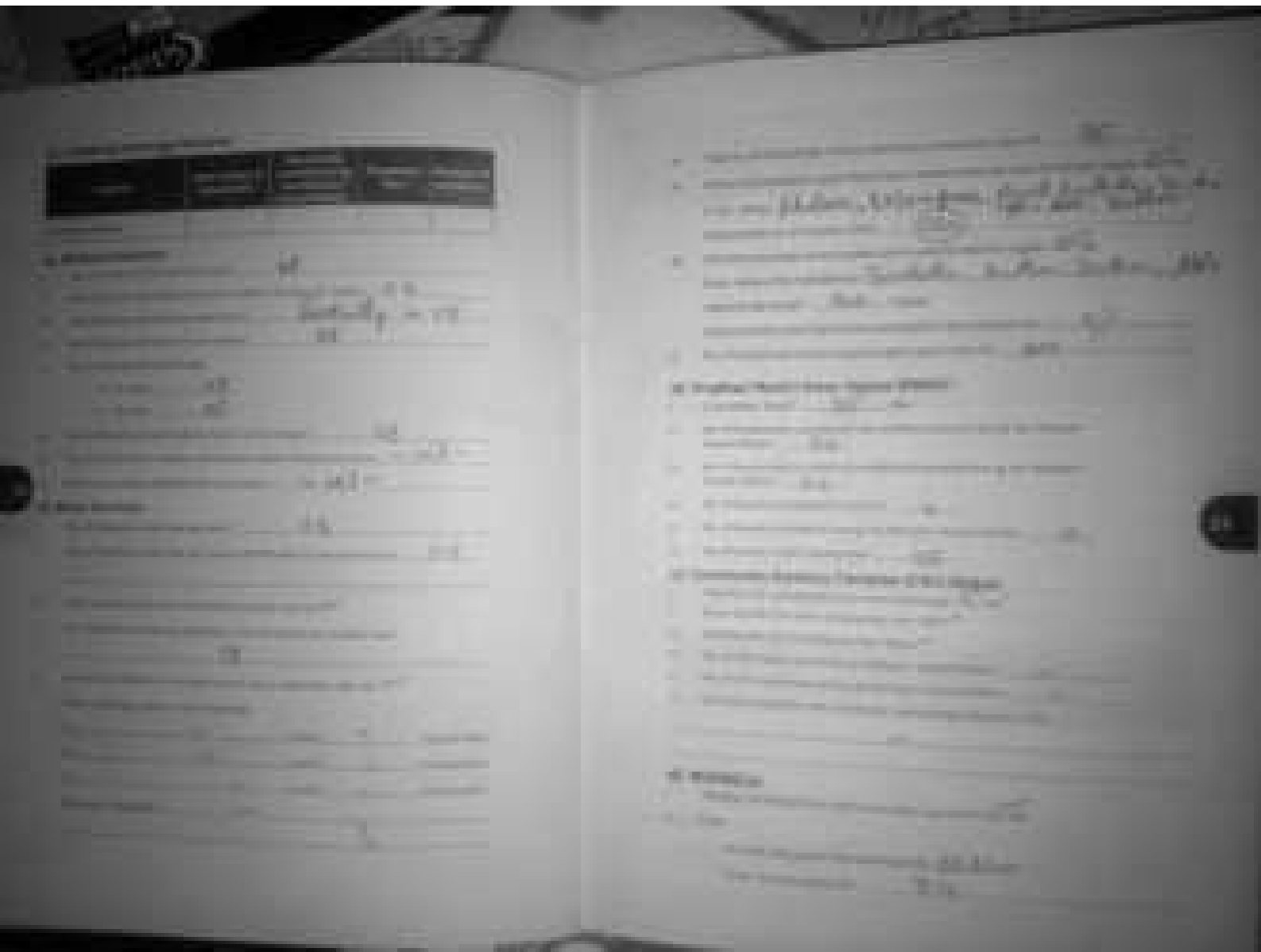

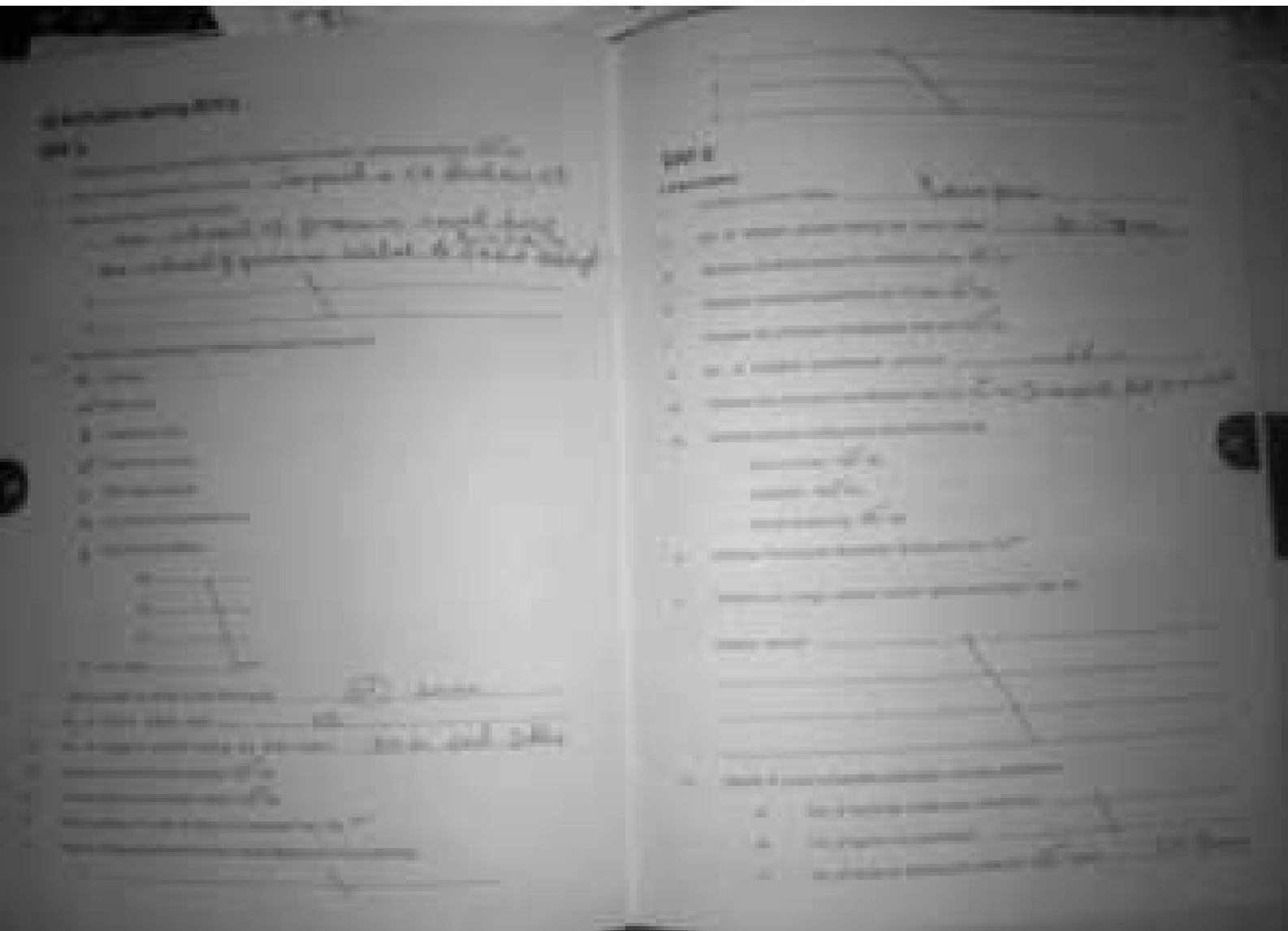

1. Definition of a function
 A function f from a set A to a set B is a rule that assigns to each element x in A exactly one element y in B .
 We write $f: A \rightarrow B$.
 The set A is called the domain of f , and the set B is called the codomain of f .
 The image of x under f is denoted by $f(x)$.
 The range of f is the set of all elements y in B such that $y = f(x)$ for some x in A .
 A function f is called injective (or one-to-one) if $f(x) \neq f(y)$ whenever $x \neq y$.
 A function f is called surjective (or onto) if every element y in B has at least one element x in A such that $f(x) = y$.
 A function f is called bijective (or one-to-one and onto) if it is both injective and surjective.

2. Properties of functions
 (a) Composition of functions
 If $f: A \rightarrow B$ and $g: B \rightarrow C$ are functions, then the composition $g \circ f: A \rightarrow C$ is defined by $(g \circ f)(x) = g(f(x))$.
 (b) Associativity of composition
 If $f: A \rightarrow B$, $g: B \rightarrow C$, and $h: C \rightarrow D$ are functions, then $h \circ (g \circ f) = (h \circ g) \circ f$.
 (c) Inverse of a function
 A function $f: A \rightarrow B$ is invertible if and only if it is bijective. In this case, the inverse function $f^{-1}: B \rightarrow A$ is defined by $f^{-1}(y) = x$ if and only if $f(x) = y$.
 (d) Image and pre-image of a set
 Let $f: A \rightarrow B$ be a function. For a subset S of B , the image of S under f is the set $f(S) = \{f(x) \mid x \in A, f(x) \in S\}$.
 For a subset T of A , the pre-image of T under f is the set $f^{-1}(T) = \{x \in A \mid f(x) \in T\}$.
