NOTES

Being a part of hilly terrain, the area is prone to landslides at multiple locations. Roads, buildings and even houses are damaged to various degrees. I personally witnessed several families residing in open because of damaged houses. Immediate attention is required to alleviate sufferings of poor masses.

34 Most families fall below poverty line as there are hardly any avenues for economic upliftment. Women power can be harvested through dairying, fisheries and providing them skill training programmes.

Panchayat Laxidora comprises of 4 wards of Nowgam Kandi area which is about 4 kms away from main Laxidora. In addition, the govt departments catering to Laxidora do not operate in Nowgam Kandi which is when operated by govt departments from Wagdora zone. So people of Nowgam want their area to be elevated to status of separate panchayat.
