

L) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

- I Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07):
 - 1 New building for Govt High School adjacent along with regularization of land from Jamia Masjid leading to School.
 - 2 Proper fencing of Schools in adjacent & nearby particularly Govt. primary School Salsala.
 - 3 Power transformer (crack down) for Jati - Urmanan colony Takliya village along with HT/LT poles.
 - 4 The inhabitants of Takliya village are demanding the separate Kuccha village.
 - 5 Health Center for P.H. Majidat & Kati Shops for both Majidat & Takliya.
 - 6 Construction of Landslide Protection from House of Mohd. Hayat Khan to A.H. Khan Des Majidat.
 - 7 Fencing of Samstan qat for Sikh Community along with footpaths from the House of Dampat Singh to Pandeyat qat.
- II Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer.

The major Complaint was regarding the Govt High School of Majidat. School has only 4 classes for 97 Students. 2 Classrooms are kept for 9th & 10th where as other 2 are occupied by classes (12th to 6th) & (9th to 8th). The difficulty faced by Students is self

i) Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 67)

1. New buildings for Govt. High School Napiblat along with rehabilitation of house from Janaka village leading to school.
2. Proper fencing of schools in Napiblat & Talsiya particularly Govt. primary school Sita May 100.
3. Power transmission (wires) for Sita-Handa Colony-Talsiya villages along with HT/LT poles.
4. Health Center for Napiblat and Eathor. Shops for both Napiblat & Talsiya villages.
5. The inhabitants of Talsiya villages are demanding the separate Revenue village. Construction of landline protection from house of Govt. Hospital near to school and one Napiblat.
6. Fencing of Shamla ghat for Sita community along with footpaths from the house of Damodar up to Panchayat ghat.

ii) Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer

The major complaint was regarding the only government High School of Napiblat. The school has only 4 classes for 92 students. Two classes are kept for 9th & 10th where as other two are occupied by classes (11th to 12th) and (12th to 13th). The difficulty faced by students is self-explanatory. In this case adequate

infrastructure need to be taken on priority basis.
