On the otherhand, Jalshakti/PHE Deptt. complaints that Peoples are not registering their connections as there are only 18 legal connection and 294 illegal connection in Parshulla-B Panchayat.
II	Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:
100	1 Community toilet complex construction and Panchayat Shiksha construction.
100	2 Construction of Footbridge at Ghatwadi.
100	3 Laying of new pipelines in every ward.

100	5 Opening of JK Bank/Kid Center Branch.
