Sub:- Back to Village (B2V3) programme – suggestions.

In connection with conduct of "Third Phase of Back to Village" tour programme to 'Ghordi Khass East', some suggestions in nutshell are put forth as under for kind perusal and for further course of action by the concerned departments for the sake of the public:

- (i) The core issue is the dilapidated condition of the road connecting Udampur and Ghordi Khass and non-availability of a good conditioned Ambulance paying way of putting the life of common people in risk in case of an emergency. Some posts are lying vacant in the PHC which need to be filled, a Gynaecologist or a lady doctor posted there and an Ambulance (108) provided to the PHC.
- (ii) The Education system needs to be explored/strengthened. Vacant posts to be filled in and subjects of History, Geography, Political Science introduced in the Higher Secondary School.
- (iii) Irrigation system needs to be strengthened in order to make the farmers enable to cultivate the seasonal crops. But with this, as demanded, measures need to be taken to protect the villagers from menace of the monkeys who damage their crops.
- (iv) The disposal of the PHC flows in the irrigation canal which needs to be diverted towards nallah to protect the crops.
- (v) Poles require to be erected; electric wires tightened and Transformer shifted from Pandhi Station to road side for safety purpose.

The demand of pending payment of works was raised. Further, it was demanded that the ratio of wages & material component of 60:40 be restored in order to enable some works to get completed.
