The Main Complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer was that the Main Demand put forth during B2V1 & B2V2 like improvement of road structure, power supply, setting up of P.H.C. at A.H.C. P.H.C. related to P.H.E. Project were not fulfilled.
