3.	There is need of approx. 24 electric poles to be replaced in place of wooden poles in Upper Bagh area.

	<u>Renovation of Roads :-</u> Except some portion, approx. the road from Bhella to Panshair is in dilapidated condition and need to be renovated as early as possible.
