The visit was fruitful, the newly completed drainage system with cemented tiled link road in the GP was inaugurated. It was also assessed that the said panchayat being spread over a large area on both sides of National Highway and Marketing / Business scope is much better but faces a lot of problem due to local Govt. Mandi & kandi for agriculture produce as the land of GP is also fertile.
