

II) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

I	Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:
1.	All the internal roads and of the wards are in very bad condition. Needs to be metalled or tiled.
2.	Irregular supply of drinking water. A reservoir in ward - is in very bad condition. Needs immediate repair.
3.	Low voltage of electricity is a big problem. shortage of electric poles. At some places, the wires are supported by trees.
II	Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:
1.	A Primary Health centre (PHC) is needed in Panchayat
2.	A Tube well in Panchayat
3.	Replacement of old PHE pipes, as the number of connections has increased many times.
4.	Up-gradation of Transformers of all wards.
5.	Need of almost 70 electric poles and wires for proper electric connections.
6.	Concrete drain from Agore chowk to Thathi chowk.
7.	All internal roads need to be metalled.
8.	Road to Cremation ground to be metalled.
III	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions: (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)
	The first and foremost priority should be on internal roads, as they are in very bad condition. Timely release of funds under different schemes, so that development works can be done. Some vocational training centres for ladies should be started like tailoring, stitching etc. A public library should be made functional in Panchayat for students.
