I) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

I	Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer: There is inadequate drinking water supply to the people. Inadequate electricity supply. Poor maintenance of roads major demands neglected in B2V, and B2V2 still pending for redressal.
II	Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far: ⇒ Establishment of medical sub Centre. ⇒ Constt of water storage reservoir. ⇒ Constt of road from Khodi to Surgeon and Khodi to Gagel through R & B. ⇒ Constt of Dug well at Khodi ⇒ Constt of Community Hall at Khodi ⇒ Establishment of new schools & Anganwadi Centres
III	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions: (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.) On my visit to Khodi village, I found that all families belong to ST category and are mostly poor people. In this age of advancement, there is not any health centre, veterinary centre or sufficient drinking water available. The only Govt. institution is BMS Khodi but without footpath or fencing. These roads should be improved and maintained.
