The people of the panchayat Natga Kathuigund have expressed their dissatisfaction over the ^{literally} neglectful and ^{unfriendly} approach of administration towards their issues and grievances. People complained almost against every department except education. They fairly told the UPD that their faith in a sensitive & people friendly Administration has dwindled and dented adversely. This is all because not any major work demand during previous B2V programmes was ^{addressed} ^{engaged}.

Major/urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:

- 1) Macadamisation and widening of Kathuigund Chitga Road.
- 2) Repairment of lanes.
- 3) PHE/Jal Shakti issues particularly at Madbal Mohalla.
- 4) Repairment of Transmission line.

Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

The panchayat Natga Kathuigund has little to celebrate and bank on. Almost all the lanes of the village, nalla & Kuls need immediate repairment. The PHE needs immediate repairment of electric poles & transmission lines needed or needs to be repaired to make the access of people to electricity a reality. The old water pipe is adversely hit by the non-sustainable approach of the deptt of Jal Shakti. The Mohalla Madbal is adversely hit by the non-sustainable approach of the deptt of Jal Shakti.

Score of households have no access to drinking water for. Instead of chadoora, of the said Mohalla is supplied from Sogam. They shall have a sign of relief.
