GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:

Supply of LT network & the conductors are tied & supported with fruit trees. This needs immediate attention ~~as~~ as this poor network is posing threat to human life. A sufficient no. of electric poles also need to be installed through the Habitation.

Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:

- (1) Forest Depto. Sale centre at Choon to be made functional.
- (2) Installation of Electric poles & replacement of conductors throughout the Habitation.
- (3) Availability of Sufficient Drinking water & installation of Borewells wherever feasible.
- (4) Establishment / Functioning of Agri. office at Choon.
- (5) Establishment of playfield ⁱⁿ around the the Habitation.
- (6) Establishment of Handicraft Centre, Cor. of R.H. (corner of Nana Hall) at Qadbagh.

Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

(The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)

The people of the area are gentle, lively & co-operative. However, most of the population showed dis-interest in B2V3 as none of the works reflected during B2V1 & B2V2 have so far been taken up the major departments, especially PDD & R&D. It is suggested that the electricity distribution network & erection of poles/conductors needs to be taken as first priority followed by Modernisation of Roads as reflected in B2V1 / B2V2 & now in B2V3.
