The employees of SI dept. allotted to the PPT Kail are seldom available to the Supt. / Pmt. If someone comes in the PPT meeting, he is either daily wages or IVR class employee, who is unable to decide anything.

The employees from dept. like Agriculture, L.O.D., social forestry, etc. also seldom attend the meeting of the gram PPT.

I Major report with comments: The following selected areas are taken into consideration:

1. Bridge over nullah at Lunkapuri village.
2. Ground clearance of chul. line by creation of poles.
3. Inst. village due to lengthy line, need atleast 3 or 4 KVA T/P in Kail PPT.

3. Upgradation of link roads in the PPT.

4. Road from Kail to Hathi via Mohalla Kallian.

II General assessment of visit and suggestions:

The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.

The people of the PPT, Kail were generally reluctant to attend the meeting of B.V.3, because an agra work has been taken up which was allotted to B.V.2 & B.V.3. However, they were aware of all the govt. schemes. The emphasis of bulldozing & grading was also made. The agra dept. doesn't visit the panchayat. If an high official visit the area and better facilities to make the nature of development can be achieved and the people of Kail shall welcome the govt. initiatives.
