I) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:

- i) Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:
 - a) Irregular water supply by the PHE Deptt.
 - b) Poor quality of works executed by PWD & RDO
 - c) Low voltage in ward no 1 & 2 of the GP.
 - d) The only road connecting the wards 4 & 7 is in dilapidated condition and is being used by the crusher owners for transportation mining material by using heavy dumpers thus causing extensive damage to the road.
 - e) Illegal mining from the Birhinon Nallah causing flood threat and loss to the Govt. exchequer.
 - f) Improper sanitation & drainage system in the GP.
 - g) Illegal sale of ground water drawn from the well in ward no 6, thus causing loss to the Govt. exchequer.

ii) Major/ Urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:

- a) Black Topping of existing T-road in the GP, connecting to w# 4 & 7.
- b) Establishment of PHC/any health sub-center in the Gram Panchayat.
- c) To utilize the natural water resources of GP in Judicial manner to mitigate the water supply problem.
- d) To construct an irrigation canal/kanal along left Bank of Nallah from w# 03 to 06, which can be used for irrigation of land as well as for drainage to avoid water logging.
- e) Create work along the left Bank of Nallah to avoid flood threat.
- f) Flaying ground in the both villages i.e. upperli Dhenori and lowerli Dhenori of the GP.
- g) Hand pumps at least one in each ward of the GP.

iii) Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

The GP despite nearer to the municipal limits of the Udhampur town is lacking in basic amenities improper water supply, road connectivity, sanitation drainage system etc. Though GP is very resourceful and can overcome these problems by utilizing their own resources like having adequate surface & ground water in the GP and can be utilize to mitigate drinking water requirement. The revenue can also be generated by GP if they are allowed to collect the royalty over illegal mining from Birhinon Nallah and this amount can be used for overall development of the GP.

The village upperli Dhenori i.e. w# 1 & 2 is having very good potential of dairy farming but all they need is assistance from the concerned depts.

The overall socio-economic status of the GP can raised by with the coordination of Govt. functionaries.

2. That during last year rainy season the pully got damaged because of the increased water flow.
