Message

I am delighted to learn that the 3rd version of the much-acclaimed *Back to Village-3 (B2V3)* programme, a unique and ambitious exercise of taking government to the doorstep of people is being organized from 2nd to 12th October 2020, across Jammu & Kashmir.

In June 2019, the Government of Jammu and Kashmir embarked on the *Back to Village* programme, which involved the visit of over 4000 Gazetted officers of J&K to every Panchayat and spending two days and a night there. It was also an opportunity to support the newly constituted Panchayats. The programme was a huge success. Villagers were welcomed and feted by populace eager to share its troubles and concerns they had perceived as an unresponsive administration. In fact such was the response generated by the programme that the Hon'ble Prime Minister made a mention of it in his Independence Day speech, calling it "a festival of development, public participation and public service".

Inspired by the success of the programme, the government organized the *Back to Village-2 (B2V2)* in November 2019. This time the focus was on ensuring that funds and services resolved to the Panchayats were used without any bottlenecks and that beneficiary welfare schemes actually reach the last person in the queue. The Hon'ble Prime Minister made a mention of the programme in his Independence Day speech of 2020.

The upcoming version of the *Back to Village-3 (B2V3)* programme will be an attempt to undertake a sustained and determined developmental push in the region. The actual programme will be preceded by a three week Jan Abhiyan (Awami Muhim) which shall focus on 3 interconnected goals: Jan Sunwai (Awami Sunwai) - Public grievances, Muhim Barai-e-Haqooq - Public Service Delivery and Unnat Taragiyati Muhim (Dighi Taraqiyati Muhim) - Delivery of Development on ground.

I am confident that this unique effort shall earn the respect of the people of Jammu and Kashmir and that it will be remembered for long as a unique and sincere effort of the government to reach the doorsteps of the people.
