4	Link Road from Shara to Bikhayan via chabber is a long Pending demand of the people of these areas. Public of these areas suffers badly due to non-connectivity.

1	Urgent requirement of one Ambulance at block headquarter Lack of it cause unfortunate events especially with pregnant women
