

## Message

Jammu and Kashmir continues to witness a transformation of Panchayati Raj institutions ever since their constitution in 2010. Through the first of its kind initiative - 'Back to Villages' and the Government's decision of delegating funds, functions and functions to PRIs, great tools democracy has flourished in the Union Territory. As a next step in this direction, the phase 3 of the 'Back to Village' programme 3 is being held from 2nd October to 12th October 2020, which will give a deeper push to the institutionalization of PRIs.

While the first S2V focused on interaction and information on local needs, the second S2V focused on strengthening and institutionalizing Panchayats, finalizing the newly enacted PRIs and focusing on saturation and 100% coverage of individual beneficiary oriented schemes.

Now, building on the foundation laid by S2V1 and S2V2, the S2V3 has been planned as an 'Action' edition with focus on implementation and execution. This edition will aim to address grievances and needs by concrete action on the ground, thus making it more ambitious and action packed.

Further, local demands are being taken up through a three month long youth, outreach epithet- 'Samuhik Samman Melaan', with 25 state concurrent and interconnected goals of public grievance redressal, public service delivery and delivery of development on ground. S2V3 is also an occasion to assess government functioning and service delivery through an unapostified platform Government-PRI interface.

I appeal to all Panchayat representatives as well as people to come forward and proactively participate in the program, thereby making governance more participatory, transparent and responsible.

I also urge the Deputy Commissioners to coordinate the work of officers to support Panchayat mitigate the better outcomes and ensure adherence to COVID SOPs while strengthen village outreach activities.

I am confident that the people and officials who will come together due to the initiative will replicate the success of earlier S2V programmes.
