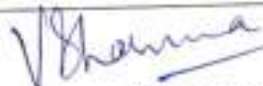

I) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

I	Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer: Water distribution is the major problem brought to notice. Pipes were destroyed by P.M.G.S.V. works six months back but neither P.M.G.S.V. department nor P.H.E. department bothered to repair. Public is forced to walk two kilometres to fetch water.
II	Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far: Electric transformer for which inauguration was done in B2V2 but nothing was done afterwards.
III	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions: (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.) Water shortage, Road connectivity and transformer should be addressed immediately as public is very pessimistic about government approach. The response to B2V3 was very lukewarm from the public.
