2. PDS outlet of rankara halqa and enhancement in PHH ^{My cluster expects} in Gujaripati.

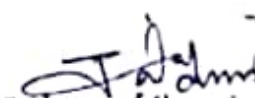
3. Renovation of Boy Middle School at rankara
