The public is facing very much difficulties and hardships because of non-availability of road from Asthen Mahalle to Freslab Top. Patients and even Pregnant ladies died because of this problem. Non availability of clean drinking water directly affects the health and hygiene of poor people. Lack of any middle school hampers the education of ST/poor students in the EP.

The population of the EP is comprising upon STs, BPLs and financially downtrodden without any agricultural lands hardly making their two ends meet.

34 They need special attention with regard to developmental works especially in road connectivity drinking water facility, opening of middle school and Anganwadi centres in various wards so that the little children of poor people may be nourished and educated.

Ambulance in the PHE ^{is} non-functional since four years. Some pregnant ladies even die on the way while reaching to medical facility on shoulders.
