3. Disabled handicapped asked for pension. Out of 10 persons only 2 are benefited in this Ppt. As per the urgent/public demand is Road connectivity. From where it is possible. As the village Ppt. is in a worst position, have more than 250 small in the village and total population is 1500 as per survey report and not connected with the road facility. It is late people of this Ppt. who demanded up-gradation of their middle school to High School.

Being far from Doda, Kanganwala & deprived of the basic & rural facilities like that of Road Connectivity, the area is the most backward Ppt. of Doda. Due to the lack of this basic facility, people of this area are not up to mark, which work done by the PBD & PHE are not up to mark, which adds to the problems of the people. As the road facility from Bais to Bais is already under the new survey for NH (Government Subsidized) to Bais. The Ppt. should be linked with Bais via UPS highway. Which is a situation almost at the level of a village Bais. Bais is a small village with a road which is the only demand of the people of this Ppt. is to get this road facility. It is late people of this Ppt. who demanded up-gradation of their middle school to High School.
