Describe the structure of the human eye and the function of the various parts.

The human eye is a complex organ that allows us to see. It consists of several parts, each with a specific function. The cornea is the clear, outer layer that protects the eye and helps to focus light. The iris is the colored part of the eye that controls the size of the pupil. The pupil is the opening in the center of the iris that allows light to enter the eye. The lens is a transparent, biconvex structure that focuses light on the retina. The retina is the light-sensitive layer at the back of the eye that converts light into electrical signals. The optic nerve carries these signals to the brain. The ciliary muscles are responsible for changing the shape of the lens to focus on objects at different distances. The aqueous humor is the clear fluid that fills the space between the cornea and the lens. The vitreous humor is the clear, gel-like substance that fills the space between the lens and the retina.

The general public of Panchayat Baranow Bologra block Jhangeri have lot of grievances regarding the works proposed during B2V1 and B2V2 were not initiated except PHE. Moreover, the representative deployed by Deptt in programme are not capable to resolve the issues of the public, most of the Deptt deploy low ranking employees which seems that they are not taking this programme seriously.
General suggestion is that the works identified by the Panchayat must be reflected on Common Portal.
