III	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions) Panchaj Sali B is located in hilly area where road connectivity is not available in all-weather seven months. Panchaj Ghar building is also in the worst condition which requires renovation immediately. Water facilities are also not available. There is urgent need of new water schemes. Middle school Salyar which also deserve for up gradation from middle to high.
