They have to walk 15 km still in order to carry their ration and though this limited the whole day if not get the ration and return home with empty bags and empty stand.
		The reason for being boycott of GRI-3 was even not a single demand has been full filled. Ration-depot has much more expectation from GRI programme but now they thought that Adm. has speaking them.
		After a glowing of 3 days, came to conclusion that overall development will only be possible if only Road Connectivity will be there.
