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The people of the Panch. including Panch. members who were present during the programme were cooperative. Most of the facilities of the Panch. are developed except few which need care. Drainage is the major problem in some wards which could be addressed with the funds available and many works have been kept in the resolution passed by the Gram Sabha. The major problem of the majority of the people is regularization of the land on which their houses have been constructed. Because of this they couldn't avail the house loan and other facilities which need regularization. Overall, BVS was a successful programme except for poor participation of the people due to Covid-19 outbreak.
