1) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:

The Area since fall in kandi belt. Thus there is acute shortage of water in the village. Moreover the area is not well connected by the network of roads. The terrain is inaccessible hence road is also one of major problem. The area is well gifted by both mountains and greenish forest cover. Thus if it is well connected by roads, it can be proved to be fruitful for boosting tourism.

Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:

The staff in the PHC. Koly is not is up to date. There is shortage of doctors and other paramedical staff and till date no action has been taken. Again supply of H₂O is also a major problem, which have not been fully solved till date.

Overall assessment of visit and suggestions.

For improvement in water facilities, the water can be lifted from the near by yik river and a processing of water plant should be implanted near the yik River. This water can be utilized for both drinking as well as irrigation facilities. Besides that road connectivity can be improved by providing more fund to the panchayat and all work should be done under the panchayat.
