II	Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:
①	During the Bal Sabha in the Halga, the major demand put forward by the youth was the establishment of play field like volley Ball Court, Basket Ball Court etc which has not been taken cognizance during B2V1 & B2V2, they spell out.
②	There is a dire need of establishing the Veterinary centre in the village as the live stock population is considerably large to meet out the demand.
III	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions: (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)
