The area since fall in lands belt. This line is a water shortage of water in the village. Moreover the area is not well connected by the network of roads. The terrain is inaccessible and road is also one of major problem. The area is well gifted by lofty mountains and greenish forest cover, thus it is well connected by roads. It can be proved to be fruitful for boosting tourism.

The staff in the PHC. Kotiy is not in up to date. There is shortage of doctors and other Paramedical staff and till date no action has been taken. Again supply of H₂O is also a major problem, which have not been fully solved till date.

For improvement in water facilities, the water can be lifted from the near by river and a processing of water plant should be installed near the river. This water can be utilized for both drinking as well as irrigation facilities. Besides that road connectivity can be improved by providing more fund to the panchayat and all work should be done under the Panchayat.
