	- School at Lak Shole is not functioning from last 1.5 year. Most of the time teachers are absent. During the visit, undesignated inlets there, grass and weeds were found in the school. Though two buildings are available but they are not maintained. Neighbours complained that the teachers never visited there. → Ambulance at PHC Lak is required
II	Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far
	→ Upgradation of Govt middle school Lak (anti to high school). → Panchayat Charhas not been connected by road and moreover it is being used by someone instead of PHCs → No dental chair at PHC Lak as such dental surgeon there is nowhere there
III	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions: (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions)
	After staying for three days and two nights at the Panchayat I came to the conclusion that problem is not much aware of the govt schemes. Few mega mega needs to be organised. Anganwadi centres sanctioned to one Panchayat are being runned by workers & helpers of other Panchayats that need to be rectified as early as possible.
