It is observed during the visit that if water supply project is being taken into consideration due to sufficient availability of water resources, the area will flourish economically very quickly.
 - iv) As per location, the road from village Gokhale to Gokhale and from Gokhale to Kular and Gokhale to Kular are being constructed. The income of the people of the area will automatically enhance from double to triple as the area is most attractive from tourism point of view. Hence, it is strongly recommended to the concerned authorities that the matter may be view favourably in the interest of Gokhale.
