I approach to your good self with the following few lines and hope a favourable action from your self that my Panchayat in the Border Area adjoining A.L.C. I bring to your kind notice that a Tractor Road was constructed by the Rural Development Department in the year 2010-11 from Dupty Lal House to Balbir House but one Kestor Chand S/o Kaka Ram had constructed the House in the Middle of Road and encroached the said Road the people of the said ward approached me and I went at site where the Road was constructed and asked him to give passage to the other people who resides on the other side of the Road but he told me that Land belongs to me and I cannot give an inch of Land. Then I wrote a application to the then Tehsildar Beri Pattan on 23-06-20. Tehsildar Beri Pattan disputed to the Patwari Halga Soyal he given a report 6-07-20 that Land belongs to Kestor Chand S/o Kaka Ram Under Khasra No 1000 by annexing a copy of Khasra Girdwari but as per my information the land title is a Dey-Shamlat but no action had been taken by the Revenue Department till now when the Road was constructed it was told that the Land is a Dey-Shamlat! In this connection I request your good self to conduct an enquiry into the said matter and order to the Senior Office of Police and Revenue Department to vacate the said Road from Encroacher so that the people of the Area can get relief.
