1) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

I	Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:
	During Gram Sabha Soupancha + Panchayat complaints that during meeting responsible officers of the various department should attend the meeting so that the issues related to the concerned department are taken up in their presence to grow confidence among the general public and steps are taken to resolve the issues then & there.
II	Major / urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:
	Major demands put forth by the Public was that of road connectivity i.e. construction of motorable bridge over river Ans to connect Gramsh to Shal and road from Shal to Dubri, bridge from lower land near Nandoli, and setting up of a J & K Bank branch at Shal. In addition to this people also demanded new transformation for wards i.e. Upper Dubri, Nandoli, Masakhara, Sona kunda, Dabur + Shal and setting up of a Sub centre or PHC at Dubri and construction of Sub centre at building of upper Dubri along with Community Sanitation complex. People were also desperate to say that if only one demand of road connectivity is addressed they don't need anything else. No demand have yet been met which were reflected earlier.
III	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions: (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)
	The area being very far flung and the terrain being hilly seems neglected in terms of development. There is no road connectivity to date and only narrow fair weather bridle paths are there due to which it is not possible to reach and tell Gram Sabhas in each ward even in a week. It seems that connectivity has also discouraged field functionaries to regularly visit the area and attend to the problems faced by the people. But it does not mean that nothing has happened. RSD department is doing some good work especially under PMGSY where the people have benefited a lot and a number of very good houses have been constructed. Since the people have great hope from the Back to Village Programme, such visits should be planned in such a way that all the field functionaries should be available during meetings. At least one major demand of the area should be considered settling aside others.
