In June 2019, the Government of Jammu and Kashmir introduced the Bodo-2 Village programme, which involved the visit of over 2000 Government officers to 1000 Panchayats and spending two days and a night there. The Hon'ble Prime Minister again made mention of the programme in his Independence Day address on 15th Aug.
