1.	PHE water facility is not available in G.P. people of the Saidpora are facing immense problem most people have fallen sick due to use of Zangair Canal water most of people have kidney problems. Ry B: Roads are in worst condition. Roads have not be magdamsed since long back. water logging in common during rainy days POD: Wooden poles are still erected in every ward by electricity remains available for 3-4 hours per day only 3-4 of transfers.
II	Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:
	→ water facility should be given to the G.P. → Roads should be magdamsed immediately. → iron poles and good water wire is required → water scheme should be started and water tanker should be given to the people of Saidpora, so that they donot have to travel for 1 bucket of water to Damsarpore.
