# I) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:

I Since most of the public demands made in the last two BZV programmes have remained unfulfilled, so anger of public regarding the same was observed and hence people stressed on the fulfilment of the same. People complained about the poor road connectivity from Dardapora to Sathogam. People also complained regarding the inclusion of BPL families into APL category. Furthermore, complaint regarding the pitable condition of Health & Education Sector were received.

II Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:

- ① The most important & urgent public requirement of the local panchayat is of modernisation & upgradation of main road from Dardapora to Sathogam.
- ② People don't have the availability of safe drinking water. Thus, need for extension of Budhama Rajdhani water Schemes towards this panchayat is a necessity.
- ③ Need of NTPHE with provision of Ambulance, Doctor & other medical staff (4) Widow Rehabilitation plan.

III Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:  
(The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)

Although most of the demands have remained unfulfilled but it was observed that people still have faith on Govt. & were thus very anxious of BZV3 programme. People stressed that such kind of programmes can improve the standard of living of people only if the plans formulated by Gram Sabha are fully operational and if works under such programmes are carried out under the supervision of Visiting officers.
