Message

I am delighted to learn that the 3rd version of the much-acclaimed Back to Village-2 (BTV-2) programme, a unique and ambitious exercise of taking government to the doorstep of people is being organised from 3rd to 12th October 2020 across Jammu & Kashmir.

In June 2018, the Government of Jammu and Kashmir embarked on the Back to Village programme, which involved the visit of over 4000 Government officers of J&K to every Panchayat and spending two days and a night there. It was also an opportunity to support and strengthen the newly constituted Panchayats. The programme was a huge success. Visiting officers were welcomed and feted by populace eager to share its troubles and trouble with what they had perceived as an unresponsive administration. In fact such was the enthusiasm generated by the programme that the Hon'ble Prime Minister made a mention of it in his "Man Ki Baat", calling it "a feature of development, public participation and public awareness."

Encouraged by the success of the programme, the government organised the Back to Village-2 (BTV-2) in November 2019. This time the focus was on ensuring that funds and facilities allocated to the Panchayats were used without any bottlenecks and that beneficiary oriented schemes actually reach the last person in the queue. The Hon'ble Prime Minister again made mention of the programme in his Independence Day speech of 2020.

I believe the upcoming version of the Back to Village-2 (BTV-2) programme will be an attempt at a concentrated and determined developmental push in the region. The actual programme shall be preceded by a three week Jan Adhyas (Awareness Month) which shall focus on 3 concurrent and interconnected goals: Jan Surveksh (Awareness Survey) - Public grievances redressal, Aashirvad Adhyas (Month Daro-dar) - Public Service Delivery and Udaat Gauri Aashirvad (Daily Taradapat Month) - Delivery of Development on ground.

I am confident that this unique effort shall earn the respect of the people of Jammu and Kashmir and that it will be remembered for long as a unique and sincere effort of the government to reach the doorstep of the people.
