- Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:
1. people complain about the non-availability of facility. Even in the 21st Century some areas like Peer Mahalla Zadora are not yet covered under any scheme for water supply. Same is the case with N. Nawgam village.
 2. The condition of electric supply, electric wires, electric poles is very shabby. The wires are faulty carried over by broken wooden poles pose serious threat to the people's lives.
 3. The Primary Health Subcentre is accommodated in a rented, crowded type dilapidated building. The residents demand for a new building and its upgradation to PH.
- Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:

1. Demand for drinking water supply
2. Replacement of faulty wires/conductors and broken wooden poles
3. Demand for new building for P. Health Subcentre and its upgradation
4. Demand for a playground, Youth of Zadora have continuously pressed for this demand
5. ATM facility at Zadora is the demand of the people.
6. Renovation/Improvement/ Beautification of the lawns of Govt Girls Middle School Zadora
7. Demand for water supply for Kaseera for Irrigation/Booth Zadora & N. Nawgam

Some more demands put forth by the people during the B2V2 project
1. Immediate need for testing of Tube well water as in absence of any water supply scheme, most of the population uses Tube well water.

2. Road from Sofi Mohalla to the Shop of Mohd Maqbool and then to Nila Koushi needs immediate improvement/repairment. The condition of the drain on b/s of the road also needs attention.

3. New Khar Kaul from H/o Syed Gh Rasool to H/o Syed Aftab Ahmad needs improvement

4. Residents of Sofi Mohalla (Zadara) and Ganai Mohalla (Zadara) demand
34 Creation of New transformer points along with supply lines.

5. The teachers at Boys Primary School Lonepora (N. Nongam) are happy towards their job. The School is surrounded by huge popular trees that need to be cut as they pose risk to the property and lives. The roof of the school is broken, needs to be repaired.

6. The lawns of the Jamia Masjid Peer Mohalla (Zadara) need transformation improvement/renovation. There is a dearth of washrooms. 3-4 washrooms may be constructed.

7. Animal Husbandary Centre is lying in a rented building at Zadara and people also demand for a Sheep Centre to be established.

8. People of Zadara claim that they deserve panchayat Halqa as they outnumber in terms of population and area.

9. People demand upgradation of Road from Main Zadara to Khar Kaul to Chak-e-Sardar.
