I	Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:
1.	The condition of road from Gussider to Chitra mawatha is very bad and there are chances of further erosion if it due to heavy traffic, and there are chances of accident on this road.
2.	150 LT and 50 HT poles with sufficient material to reduce chances of accidents, because trees are being used for this purpose in place of poles.
3.	pending remuneration of P.W.D. helpers from last few months.
4.	Defunct water supply scheme from last many years and no repairment work till date.
II	Major urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:
1.	Provide 150 LT and 50 HT Poles along with upgradation of 3 no. of 100 kv transformers upto 250 kv at mawatha, mawatha and mawatha with necessary materials.
2.	Upgradation of Sub centre to P.W. level with necessary facility and adequate staff.
3.	Establishment of veterinary Sub Centre at Somachayal talga, L. mawatha - B.
4.	Revival of existing water supply scheme Commissionerment as part of line which is presently changing.
5.	Repairment of existing road from Gussider to mawatha.

2.	The existing road from Gussider to mawatha is in shambles condition and needs immediate attention to reduce the chances of accidents by providing protection walls on needed spots and other needed work on the said road to stop the further erosion and damage to the road in future.
