The Panchayat Halqa has a subcentre of Health Department. That is functioning in a private rented single room only one health worker i.e. FmPHW is working in the subcentre. The centre may be kindly upgraded to primary health centre and a building for the same may be constructed for which the Panchayat Halqa is ready to donate the land. Single FmPHW cannot look after the population of about 4000 souls of whole village. Adequate medical staff may kindly be deputed.

Condition of electrical infrastructure is in dismal condition. Wires are hanging on trees & wooden poles. LT wires are worn out. Drinking water is another major problem faced by the people. Although village has enough springs there needs to be tapped to cater the demand of water.

A single and only family of Laxmi Pundit community resides in the village namely Ramesh Kumar. I found this living example of communal harmony. Repairment of spring at Pundit Mollah has been included in Gramplan.

The youth of the Panchayat Halqa has put a demand for construction of playground. The Panchayat Halqa has state land in abundance. Due consideration should be paid to it to keep the youth away from social evils.
