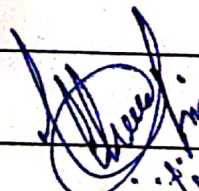

The people have generally good perception regarding the Govt departments. The department especially Education and Rural Development show best performance. Action should be taken against PDD, Revenue and Social welfare as major complaints are against them. It has been observed that Anganwadi workers, helpers and Asha's for safeguarding the health and nutrition of children, pregnant ladies, lactating mothers is commendable. Workers do not get their salaries at due time and was kept in dark how and where the salary is received. Most of the old age people were not covered in Social welfare old age scheme. Garhi Mohalla needs more attention and de-installation of HT wire passing through the school premises of Govt Hgts School, Rehan, should be brought in to practice immediately.
