

- The visiting officer shall refrain himself? herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his her interaction in the village.
- He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
- 3. While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district CSS plans
- His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR evercise.
- Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayet with relevant panchayet records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayet wise order needs to be issued in advance.
- 5. Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on www.jkpanchayet.in portal, before they leave panchayat.

Lack of proper road connectivity from Sangaldan to Chachawah A.

2. Major Public Demands that was/were reflected earlier but have not been met.

Drinking water facility for the area.

Repairing of primary school at Sarlibagi.

Different link roads within the panchayat (Details are mentioned in the booklet.)

Bank Branch.

Ration Store.

Primary Health Centre.

3. Overall assessment of the Visit Officer and suggestions.

The area is housed in a remote corner of the district and is lacking in basic facilities of life.it is purely a hilly area. Dilipadiated roads along with absence of PHC, drinking water facility and frequent power outages are compounding the problems of the people. The footprints of Govt. Offices except RDD and Education are totally absent. By and large people are not aware about the G2C services. And people were somewhat angry over the follow up action of bygone B2V phases recommendation's. Under PMAY Scheme number of Houses have been sanctioned however the "poorest person" of the village Ab. Satar Hajam S/o Ab. Karim Hajam R/o lower Soosni ward no.6 is left out.

Suggestions:-

- 1. People like Ab.Satar Hajam and others like him shall be covered under PMAY scheme as early as possible.
- 2. A PHC is of primary importance. It is lacking here. Vaccination is affected as people have cross a lot of distance for that.
- 3. A fair whether road from Sangaldan to Chachawah A is a fundamental requirement for elevating the standards of life.
- 4. A common play field in the village is need of the hour as its absence is crippling the talents of the young generation.
- 5. The local Govt. High School is housing more than 200 students (Co-ed.). It is appalling that there is no Bathroom facility for the students as well for the staff. Besides the school is understaffed that needs to be enhanced.
- 6. The Primary school at Sarlibagi shall be renovated as its roof was damaged by strong winds a couple of years ago.
- 7. A Khidmat centre of J&K Bank is essential here to help the people .It will reduce a lot of travelling burden and save time and resources of the people. People are facing a lot of hurdles in clearing Scholarship forms and other loan related documents.
- 8. Different P.Paths are required to be laid down at different wards nos. like 02, 03,04,05,06.
- 9. A link road from Railway to Salibagi is needed.

- 10. There is lot of potential for income generation through trout farming, apiculture, olive oil production etc. For this purpose the Department concerned need to be activated and staff deployed.
- 11. The primary School building at Soosni (an abandoned project) should be taken up again as the small kids have to move 3 to 4 kms.back and forth by foot through a treacherous path.
- 12. Efforts for improving water supply and electricity should be doubled by the Department concerned.
- 13. A good number of kids, expecting and lactating mothers are enrolled at ICDS centres .The infrastructure and facilities there shall be augmented.
