GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

Major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:

- a) Complete failure of PWSR Deptt. to maintain main road from Degree College to Fatehpura & onwards, by way of macadamization, const. of drainage alongside the road, fixing of Rec pipes & removal of encroachments.
- b) Shortage of hygienic drinking water supply. Demands for construction of additional SR at Chotipora or Borewell & to expedite the const. of SR at Freshwar, wants immediate attention of the Govt/ Department.

II Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:

- a) Macadamization of main road from Degree College & leading to Guljar, Fatehpura onwards & fixing of Rec pipe at main Fatehpura Chowk.
- b) Const. of drainage alongside the main road and at the spots identified in the Gram Sabha meet.
- c) Health sub centre to be made functional.
- d) Underground drainage management to be planned properly.
- e) Development of Public/ tourism park at Puthri Fatehpura.

III Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

(The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)

B2V3 was not welcome this time, as the Gramam masses were annoyed with the functioning of the government at large. Reasons assigned to this public anger was invariably failure or delays in execution of identified urgent public demands raised in B2V1 & B2V2. An awkward situation was also faced when public observed absence of Line Departments mainly from PWD, PHE, Horticulture, Social Welfare & PDD. Even RDD was blamed to have failed in addressing the grave issue of cutting aged poplar trees in the compound of P.H. Land at Pt. Ghar which poses threat to the lives of inmates of vicinity.

To address the urgent demands of supplying sufficient drinking water by way of new schemes like chuntpora scheme or Bore well for Kaslab, Sish Mohalla, macadamization of road passing through Kasla & const. of proper drainage system which become unavoidable to the town these urgent public demands in hand for execution sooner as possible.
