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GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. As per the data obtained from diff. deptts. And the feed back from the general public the working in the G.P in some extent in Satisfactory.
 - a) The health Deptt. Is doing very well that 1420 beneficiaries out of 1502 are availing the benefits of Golden cards.
 - b) 80% availing the benefits of E-shram cards.
 - c) As per the report of Patwari 70 land passbooks have distributed and rest are in under process.
 - d) In inheritance mutations are pending as most of the land in the GP is under Custodian.
 - e) About 95% peoples in the GP have soil health and KCC cards.
- 2) One Csc is working in the GP bhawan and peoples availing the benefits.
- 3) There are 34 SHGs working in GP they have no fixed place in the GP to conduct meetings.
- 4) Identification of 20 persons in the GP is pending due to the boycott of GP members.
- 5) JK bank salehar and Grameen bank Rehal Providing loan/ subsidy to the SHGs and the needy peoples.
- 6) Jal Shakti:- Pani samilies have been formed in the GP. Field testing kit is not available in the GP.
