General assessment of the visit

People warmly welcomed me, however the participation of people was meagre. On interacting with the people a general discontentment was noticed because the demands listed in the previous programmes have not been fulfilled. After detailed deliberations, following 05 demands have been prioritized:-

- 1) Removal of poplar trees around the Panchayat building, keeping in view the threat to life posed by these trees and for the development of the Panchayat building premises.
- 2) The Govt. High School building is without a Library & Laboratory. No electric fitting has been done & the school is without a ground. Old buildings need to be demolished for developing a small playground for the school.
- 3) The incomplete NTPHC building needs to be completed immediately. People were disgruntled with slow pace of work.
- 4) Removal of encroachments upon Badron-Nagam link road.
- 5) Establishment of a J&K Bank Branch & ATM. The village comprises 950 households with a population of more than 4500.
