



Old buildings need to be demolished for Leveloping a Small playground for the School. 3) The intemplete NTPHC building needs to be completed immediately. People were disgruntled with slow pace of work. 4) Removal of encroachments upon Badron-Magam link load. 5) Establishment of a Jak Bank Branch & ATM. 
