Assessment of visit and suggestions:

Balihote B panchayat is one of remote areas of CD block ukhral which is not connected by roads. Electricity and water supply is upto the mark in the village with exceptions. Despite being high area wise panchayat the network of schools is meagre with only one MS and two P. schools. Health sector is completely lacking with not an even single first aid centre/ Dispensary. The panchayat consist of mostly scheduled Tribe pop. living in below poverty level with substandard quality of life. Overall the economic condition of people with agrarian resources is poor.

Suggestions/ Demands:

1. Main Road connecting this panchayat to ukhral is under construction from last decade but unfortunately not going at enough pace. It should be focused and Speeded up.
2. Atleast there shall be a primary school in each ward especially 1, 2, 4, 5 & 7. Besides MS Narthyal shall be upgraded to High School. Ample staff shall be provided to MS Narthyal.
3. Construction of Dispensary any where in the Panchayat is need of hour.
4. Anganwadi centres shall be provided in each ward of the panchayat especially W.N. 2, 4, 6 & 7.
5. Construction of Panchayat ghar shall be started as soon as possible.
6. Panchayat Balihote B was previously falling under Ramban block. Later it was shifted to CD block Ukhral but unfortunately Tagging and disbursing of PMAY cases is still ^{done} under Ramban block leading to inconvenience and under performance. The matter shall be resolved ASAP.
