GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the Government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.

He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.

While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and referred under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans

His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.

Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.

Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on www.jkpanchayat.in portal, before they leave panchayat.

GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER

1. Any major complaint brought to the notice of the visiting officer:

1. Major complaint is against the functioning of ITI, Rohama. The trainee of the institute interacted with the visiting officer on 29-10-2022 and raised the issue of non-availability of Principal for the last 07 years and instructors. I personally observed that biometric attendance should be made mandatory for the staff. Also, the staff should be made accountable for the ~~staff~~ ~~Apna~~ ~~or~~ ~~staff~~ ~~should~~ ~~be~~ ~~made~~ ~~accountable~~ for the smooth functioning of the institute like maintenance of students attendance, proper displaying of Time Table, etc.
2. Illegal extraction of sand and Bajri from Nallah Dekli & Viji Nallah

2. Major/urgent public demands that was/were reflected earlier but having not been addressed so far:

1. 24x7 Electricity at SDH Rohama.
2. Staff Deficiency in the staff of Govt. HS. Sec. School, Rohama in the subject of Botany, Urdu & Kashmiri to be resolved at an earliest. New subjects like EVS, Arabic, PG, Science, Computer Applications be introduced.
3. Deficiency in the staff of Govt. HS. Sec. School, Rohama to be resolved.
3. Relocation of the office of Horticulture Development Office and Treasury office.
4. water lodging at Al Jamiya Islamiya ul Banat needs immediate drain alongside.
5. concrete bund at Nallah Digh to stop land erosion

3. Overall assessment of the visit and suggestions:

As far as B2V4 is concerned, There was a good response from the inhabitants of the Halqa as most of the works / problems identified during previous B2V programs have been resolved. The pending works should be executed as early as possible. A number of services are provided by the RDO at their doorstep. Mass awareness regularly various taken should be carried out.
