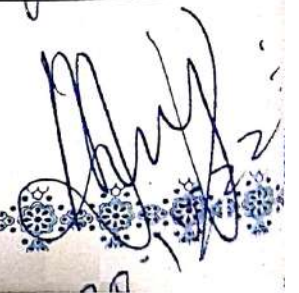

- 1 Major Complaint which has a persistent Nature from BZV is the scarcity of Drinking Water. However, Dept. of PHE has assured that the issue has been taken up with JTM and the scheme cooking installation is in Tenders process.
2. i) Childrens park ii) Renovation of HT/LT network.
iii) Facility of Piped and Treated Drinking Water iv) Storm Flood
v) Foot Bridge on Nallah Mawar at Ujroo.
- 3) i) Panchayat Halga is in dire need of Drinking Water, provide through pipes. It is suggested that Tenders process may be expedited.
ii) Gramen Bank at Uniso needs to be shifted to ground floor to ease movement of old aged and specially abled.
iii) Solar Panel as renewable source of energy may be provided to the NHPC at UNISO.
iv) Awareness about Social Security Govt. Schemes is lacking. Matter needs to be taken on priority basis. The process of registration of Youth by Financial Institutions has been started during this BZV. The process needs to be continued.
v) HT Line passing through nearly dead wooden poles needs to be renovated at an earliest to avoid any damage to life and property.
vi) A Chinar Tree and a Walnut tree overhanging a permanent shed to students at UPS Uniso and HSS Uniso and Ujroo to be removed wholly and partially.
vii) Old and obsolete type of Ambulance at NHPC Uniso to be replaced.
viii) OHT met for Uniso & Ujroo has been taken for cons. Some 4 yrs but it is almost complete but left half way for want of more works. There is also space for SR and filtration plant which yet to be constructed. The Scheme will provide drinking water to schools of villages in the Area needs to be taken under long term.



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
